He also served as a faculty member in many universities in Taiwan, including National Taiwan University, Fu Jen Catholic University and Tamkang University. Professor Chiang is a prolific poet, painter and writer. Over the years, he has received many awards, including the Golden Tripod Award and the Golden Bell Award.
