### **English Literature II (Spring 2024)**

## **Course Description:**

In this course, we will read four novels: *The Picture of Dorian Gray, The Virgin and the Gipsy, Orlando*, and *1984*. Since the 20<sup>th</sup> century encompasses a vast array of issues, movements, literary genres, and writers, it is impossible to cover all of them. Instead, we will focus on representative novels and examine issues of feminism, (homo)sexuality, imperialism, colonialism, totalitarianism, and various social, cultural, and aesthetic problems that are addressed in these works.
